# More States to Integrate Mapping Technology into Elections Systems as NSGIC Project Moves into Second Phase

The National States Geographic Information Council (NSGIC) has been awarded \$300,000 by the bipartisan Democracy Fund Voice organization for the second phase of NSGIC's Geo-Enabled Elections project. The project was launched in October 2017 to help strengthen electoral systems by supporting states in the adoption of GIS. With its second phase, the project turns to focus on working hands-on with up to ten more states as well as developing materials to support integration of GIS in elections.
