A fifth of Earths ocean floor is now mapped

When the Nippon Foundation-GEBCO Seabed 2030 Project was launched in 2017, only 6% of the global ocean bottom had been surveyed to resolutions below 1 km. The project recently announced that high resolution bathymetry data are now available for 19% of the ocean floor, which is up from 15% in just the last year.
