- I. **Call to order:** Meeting was called to order at 10:14 am; Introductions were made by the committee; ensuring attendance list was managed and quorum established.
  
- II. **Approval of the August Meeting Minutes:** August meeting minutes were distributed prior to the meeting via email. Kasey asked for a motion to approve the minutes as written. Robert motioned and Jenna seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously without discussion.
  
- III. **AGIC Conference UAS Tracks:** Kasey reminded the group to register for the symposium if they have not already done so. Symposium presenters were

- IV. Monthly Topics of Discussion:** Kasey gave the group a preview of the new AZGeo Hub webpage. The Hub site has gone live. Within the UAS workgroup page, members can find any data associated to this group. Robert told the group about his experience using such a page. From the ease of collaboration, to the seamless integration with ArcPro, it is easy to use. Jenna reminded the group of the upcoming events: AGIC Symposium and Planet Explore's free and virtual demonstration.
- V. Information or topics for future meetings:** The next meeting will be December 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020. Workplan review, upcoming year's events, and development will be discussed.
- VI. Call to the Public:** Abel brought up a proposed bill that would prohibit governmental entities to use drones made in China. It is currently waiting approval from the Senate. The question was raised, how would this be enforced at a State level? Robert informed the group that Landsat 9 will launch next year, with true 8-day repeat cycle. Additionally, a European space agency released Sentinel 2 imagery which has a 5-day repeat cycle. A software called SNAP is free to download for analysis of any kind of imagery.
