- UAS Workgroup Hub Update – Toni and Kasey created an Experience Builder page. It includes a map and Survey123 for folks to add in where they have UAS projects going on around the state. This way someone looking for data or thinking of doing their own flights, can look to see if the work has already been done. The metadata will inform users whether the information is visual only, free, of charge, etc. An overview of these submissions will be displayed using a dashboard. This is planned to go live by the time of the conference, with 'page under construction' if need be.
  
- Projects/Lessons Learned – Dave Roby from the Arizona Department of Emergency and Military Affairs shared with the group their project plan to use drones and various sensors to monitor flood and fire paths. Marisa is attending Utah's equivalent to our FHWA workshop. Sessions are being recorded and she will send them out when available.

IV. **Connected by Drones Webinar Debrief:** Kasey attended this event, so he gave a summary of some things he took away from it. Turns out the Alameda County Sheriff's Department in California had a similar idea to what Kasey is doing with the project dashboard. Theirs is up and running, with the ability to see current projects based on department or agency.

V. **Virtual Fly-In Update:**

After lunch is a technical talk on how to process data collected.
