- VI. Projects/Lessons Learned:** Tom Homan talked about the use of a drone in the Tonto Creek Bridge construction project, and he will try to get some videos posted somewhere that will be accessible.
- VII. Outreach:** Justin Eddinger talked about the career day event, mentioning that the location moved from ASU to the Audubon Center. He mentioned the need for more volunteers. They have 9 professionals and 2 schools signed up so far. He also mentioned that they got approval for drone demos and are planning 2 demos, a data collection demo & a 1 shot film with an FPV drone. For Geography week, he has 5 school visits set up so far. Green Drone will be at AZ Drone Fest, sharing a booth with AGIC and doing a small presentation on drones in the environment. Lastly, Justin mentioned that they just completed their fall data collection on the lower salt river restoration project and are gearing up for field season starting on 10/31.
- VIII. Workgroup Update and Discussion:** Jenna Leveille led a discussion about the possible merger between the 4D Geospatial workgroup and the UAS workgroup. She mentioned that in the event of the groups merging, the drone specific discussions will still need to be held outside of the 4D Geospatial workgroup. The data collection aspect of the UAS group does fit well in the 4D Geospatial workgroup though. Robert Davis asked if anyone knows of a group specifically for drone pilots. Jonathan Gholson mentioned that he just became aware of the Arizona Aviation Safety Advisory Group. The group agreed that we will continue to meet, but we will be thinking about and discussing a possible merger with the 4D Geospatial workgroup.
