- VI. <u>Projects/Lessons Learned</u>: Nick Bisley asked the group if anyone has experience registering a drone with a County and not an individual pilot. Chuck suggested Nick to reach out to Joe Wagner at Maricopa County Flood Control or Tom Homan at Gila County. Chuck also mentioned that anyone that is part 107 certified can fly the drone, not just the registered pilot.
- VII. Outreach: Justin Eddinger gave the following Green Drone Updates. He has a meeting today to finalize details on the GIS Career Day at ASU Drone Studio, and he also put together a survey to get contact information from people interested in helping out. Chuck mentioned that there have been 12-15 people signed up already for Geography Awareness Week in November, and he is looking for more people to sign up.
- VIII. Workgroup Update and Discussion: Kasey led a discussion about a possible Merger with the 4D Geospatial Data Workgroup (formerly the Lidar Workgroup). It was decided that this UAS Workgroup will be invited to the next 4D Geospatial Data Workgroup meeting on September 27th as a test, and then discuss the potential merger in our October meeting.

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- IX. AGIC Education and Training Symposium Review: This year, there were 270 attendees to the conference. Tom Homan from Gila County also did a presentation on using Trimble Business Center software for orthophotography. There was then a discussion about Trimble Business Center software including who is using it and how it works for them. This led to a discussion of various other drone mapping programs. Kasey noted that there might be a need for a presentation of some drone mapping software in the future that might include tips and tricks.

- X. Future Topics/Presentations: Jonathan Gholson is now the Deputy Director for Unmanned Operations for the Arizona Wing of the Civil Air Patrol. He talked a little bit about their Aerospace Education Program, and he might have a presentation on a future meeting. Chuck mentioned that a topic that came up at the symposium was the desire to have a beginner's fly-in event that included everything involved in flying a mission. Justin Wells mentioned possibly doing a presentation on some of the drone applications and workflow within ESRI software.
