In order to make the report more accessible to a wider audience, the group felt it would be good to change the format to sort AGIC's accomplishments around the council's strategic goals for 2023 or by a logical sort order but highlight which Governor's priority or AGIC strategic goal the accomplishment fits into.

The workgroup also found that some important GIS-related work accomplished outside of AGIC was made possible by the networking and connections provided through AGIC. As such, the workgroup decided the annual report should not only highlight the work accomplished directly through AGIC but may also include work accomplished by the counci's member agencies.
