To meet that goal, the group will identify select universities and colleges with GIS programs to help pilot the project and will create a survey for businesses that will identify the skills they are

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seeking but not getting from students. Emily also mentioned a value in interviewing students to find out what skills they felt they were missing aftering entering the workforce.

A possible second goal would be to engage in K-12 education and identify opportunities to support GIS education in schools. The group discussed identifying companies that are already working with K-12 schools, like Green Drone, and how best to support them, identifying sources of lesson plans that may already be published and available.
