- I. <u>Call to order:</u> Meeting was called to order at 10:03 am; Introductions were made by the committee; around the table and on the phone, ensuring attendance list was managed and quorum established.
- II. <u>Approval of Prior Meeting Minutes:</u> August meeting minutes were distributed prior to the meeting. Members were provided an opportunity to make corrections. A motion to approve the meeting minutes was made by Mariah and seconded by Robert. The motion passed unanimously.
- III. Workgroup Leadership: Jay Corum has volunteered to lead the group as Co-chair, pending committee approval. He is with the Bureau of Reclamation in Phoenix and has worked in GIS for about 20 years. Jenna asked for a motion to approve Jay as the co-chair and Elizabeth motioned and Robert seconded. No further discussion and the group voted unanimously to approve. Additionally, Mariah Modson has volunteered to lead the NDH Pilot Workgroup. Ben motioned to approve Mariah as the leader for the NDH Pilot project and Jatta seconded. There was no further discussion and the motion to approve passed unanimously.
- IV. <u>2021 Goals/Projects Update:</u> Jenna provided NRWG updates and elaborated on the updates and tools added to the Hub site. Elizabeth asked about the process to get an application featured and Jenna explained that the survey is the best way to share a tool/application that could be listed for the group to discuss. Gerardo suggested documenting the workflow for suggesting new applications and the group agreed that this would benefit website users to clarify the process. Gerardo volunteered to draft this document.

- VI. <u>NHD Pilot Project Status Report:</u> Mariah gave an overview of the progress the workgroup has made throughout the last year. Drew also commented on the success of the methodology and future plans for the dataset.
- VII. Workplan Review and 2022 Goals: Jenna announced that there is discussion about changing the timing of the workplan reviews at the Council level to better fit with the schedule for the Council's strategic direction plans. Jenna then reviewed the 2021 Work Plan, including the schedule for meeting dates, voting member requirements, and goals and activities. The document is posted on the website and we will begin working on the 2022 plan at the next meeting.

VIII. AGIC Updates:

 Data Committee Highlights: The group met yesterday and Linda Bell, the Regional Geodetic Advisor gave a brief welcome at the meeting. They discussed the presentations the Data Workgroups are planned to make at the conference and the new applications and partnerships that have been established on AZGeo.
