2019 Activities

Review and propose a sustainable AGIC budget

- Identify current AGIC revenue and expenditures
 - Prioritize typical expenditures for AGIC and ASLD Resource Analysis Division (RAD) funds, including the AGIC Conference, AZGEO, and external conference travel/alternatives.
 - Establish work groups as required to assist with budget initiatives.
- Explore potential AGIC revenue sources and expenditures
 - Work with AGIC Committees and Workgroups to identify and establish funding sources outside of the AGIC budget for large projects, such as AZGEO.
 - Work with other committees and workgroups to identify other funding opportunities.
- Report budget recommendations to the Council

Review and develop documentation to identify AGIC goals and priorities

- AGIC Council Memberships
 - Track and document AGIC membership appointments to confirm adherence to statute
 - Track renewal dates and send members notifications as necessary
 - Identify appropriate candidates for vacant positions and submit recommendations to Council
 - Notify Council of membership status
- Maintain National States Geographic Information Council (NSGIC) membership roster and make recommendations for changes to the AGIC Council as needed.
- Work with AGIC Committees to maintain the AGIC Organizational Chart
- Review and update AGIC publications, such as the AGIC Manual
- Review statutes pertaining to AGIC, ASLD RAD, or the State Cartographer, as needed.
