## GOALS AND ACTIVITIES

Provide a Forum and Structure to Discuss Current Geospatial Data, Initiatives and Technologies

- Create and sponsor work groups as needed
- Identify resources required to carry out proposed activities

Facilitate Interagency Coordination and Encourage Geospatial Data Sharing

- Serve as a forum to facilitate informational exchange between state, federal, tribal, regional, and local governments, the private sector and professional associations.

- Promote geospatial data sharing, and the inclusion of data in the public domain, to maximize the benefit of AZGeo as a state clearinghouse data sharing platform.
- Coordinate activities with appropriate AGIC committees as required

Develop a Data Management Plan to facilitate data sharing and use of AZGeo as Arizona's state-wide geospatial clearinghouse.

- Coordinate with the AZGeo Work Group to assure data management criteria and guidelines are consistent with AZGeo development.
- Provide advocacy and support for AZGEO by assisting the Work Group with defining the roles and responsibilities
- Provide guidance on the approach to AZGeo data curation
- Provide recommended use cases
- Coordinate with Outreach Committee to obtain stakeholder feedback on needs, requirements and use of geospatial data and AZGeo

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
