GOALS AND ACTIVITIES

- Submit three "Zone Request and Proposal Forms" to NGS by March 31, 2020
 - Form 1 – Statewide
 - Form 2 – County/Sub-county, multiple-zone complete State coverage (40 ppm)
 - Form 3 – Other area (e.g. CAP, Grand Canyon, City, etc.), non-complete State coverage (30 ppm)
- Review Final Designs with AGIC Data Committee

- Submit final zone designs to NGS by March 2021
- Recommend Arizona State Plane Statutes revisions by March 2021
